Step 2. First meeting

- We'll discuss in detail your needs, wants and expectations

- We'll identify the most suitable pricing plan and business model for you, and draw a preliminary offer



Different business models

Step 1: Choose who will pay for the journal expenses

Annual fee – paid by the organisation
+
APCs – paid by the organisation

Step 2: Choose payment plan

Flat-rate option (fixed amount of paid pages / articles per year):

Suitable for the organisations with a fixed budget and journals with a fixed publication volume

Pay per published article:

Suitable for new journals or journals aiming to increase their publication volume

Step 3. Decision

- You'll confirm your interest in ARPHA Platform
- You'll receive our final offer
- We'll prepare a contract draft for you
- Once the contract is approved, we'll sign it and will proceed to the journal setup stage



Step 4. Start of the journal migration (~ 2 months!)

- You'll fill in a detailed questionnaire to provide further information about the journal and its website design
- We'll prepare and discuss with you a design concept (~ 2 weeks)
- We'll set up your journal website on ARPHA (~ 1-1,5 months)
- We'll upload your journal's back issues, if this service is included in the contract (~ 4 weeks)



Step 5. Training and technical support

- We'll train your staff how to fully utilise ARPHA's Editorial Management system (3-4 hours)
- We'll be providing continuous technical support by replying to your questions within 24 business hours



Step 6. Indexing and archiving

- We'll verify the indexing and archiving databases provided by your previous publisher
- We'll set up an automated export for your journal's content to all relevant databases
- We'll be actively assisting you in the application process for additional databases, including Web of Science, Scopus, DOAJ, CLOCKSS, and others.
- We'll be regularly following up your journal's indexing and archiving



Step 7. Official launch on ARPHA

- We'll prepare press materials and announce the migration of your journal to scholarly newswires and our social networks
- You'll receive our guidelines & advice on successful PR and marketing activities for journals
